Celebrating the 50th anniversary of the 25th April 1974 Revolution means evoking a remarkable movement and turning point in the History of Portugal. The path to democracy, development and decolonization was opened. The Atlantic archipelagos became autonomous regions, and the country sought and won a place in the European Union. Portuguese society was modernized, education progressed and became universal, along with a greater offering and diversity in the cultural field. April changed the structures of thought, created new mentalities, and shaped the generations that make up contemporary Portugal.

Five decades later, there are multiple reasons to celebrate April's achievements, to reflect and debate the present, and envision the future. April, yesterday, today and tomorrow is the theme of this congress, that will focus on the national reality, with an emphasis on the archipelagos, and also on the repercussions of the Carnation Revolution in Europe and in the Atlantic World.
